#### **Child Abuse Prevention Tips**

With Child Abuse Awareness Month approaching, we wanted to give a few guidelines on helping your child stay safe.

- Listen to them and believe what they say
- Be aware of changes in your child's attitude or behavior
- Never discipline your child when your anger is out of control
- Never leave your child unattended; especially in a car
- Make certain your child's day care/school will only release him/her to you or someone you officially designate
- Participate in your child's activities and get to know your child's friends
- Teach your child the correct name of his/her private body parts
- Teach your child to use their voice to allow them to prevent abuse in their own life
